As December 31, 2022, approaches, please consider these important reminders regarding giving:

- Contributions to **Calvary Chapel Costa Mesa** are tax deductible as allowed by law.
- IRS rules recognize a contribution on the day of delivery. In order for contributions to be deductible for 2022, they must:
  - **By mail:** be postmarked on or before December 31, 2022.
    - Mail to: Calvary Chapel Costa Mesa, 3800 S. Fairview St., Santa Ana, CA 92704
  - **Online:** be completed by 11:59 PM Pacific Standard Time, December 31, 2022.
- The last church service of the year will be on Christmas Eve, Saturday, December 24. Contributions received on December 31 will be treated as 2022 gifts. Contributions received during the Sunday, January 1, 2023, offering will be treated as 2023 gifts.
- Online giving via the church website is always available and is a convenient option for any last-minute gifts. Go to [cccm.com/give](http://cccm.com/give) and follow the instructions.
- Please contact us for further instructions if you wish to make non-cash gifts of stock. Please note that gifts of this type should be planned well in advance to ensure that any transfer of assets will be completed by December 31, 2022.
