Day 1: Read Luke 11:1-4

In verse 1 of Luke 11 one of His disciples asks Him to teach them to pray. What are some reasons why they might want His particular instruction on prayer?

- a. Do any of your answers inform/inspire your prayer life, and if so, how?

Day 2: Read Luke 11:5-13

Jesus then illustrated principles concerning prayer using examples from everyday life. Summarize His first example from Luke 11:5-8.

- a. What was Jesus communicating concerning prayer? See also Luke 18:7 and Colossians 4:2.

Day 3: Read Luke 11:14-28

According to Luke 11:14a, after Jesus cast out a *demon*, the mute man *spoke*. Cite the varied reactions to this miracle from Luke 11:14b-16.

- a. What do the people's reactions reveal about the people themselves?



Day 4: Read Luke 11:29-36

When Jesus addressed the crowds who were seeking a sign from Him, what did He say about them? Luke 11:29a

a. From Luke 11:29b-30 describe the only sign Jesus would give them.

b. How does Matthew 12:39-40 inform your understanding of this sign.

Day 5: Review

1. What lesson(s) from chapter 11 of Luke stand out to you the most this week?

2. Which lessons can be directly applied to situations in your life right now, and what do you find the Lord speaking to you through them?
