Lesson 13

Day 1: Read Luke 14:1-14

While Jesus was at the Pharisee's house, a man with dropsy came to Him. Jesus asked the Pharisees, Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath? (Luke 14:2-3). From Luke 14:4 note and comment on:

a. What they did

b. What Jesus did

Day 2: Read Luke 14:15-24

In Luke 14:15 a guest at the table exclaimed, Blessed is he who shall eat bread in the kingdom of God, referring to the anticipated Messianic banquet, or what is known as the marriage supper of the Lamb (Revelation 19:9). In response, Jesus gave a parable about this great supper. Use Luke 14:16-24 to describe and comment on the following:

a. The master's actions (verses 16-17)

b. The guests' excuses (verses 18-20)

c. The servant's report (verses 21a, 22)

d. The master's response (verses 21-24)

e. Those the master then invited to come (verses 21b, 23)



Day 3: Read Luke 14:25-35

1. Jesus gave two illustrations of *counting the cost*. Use Luke 14:28-32 to describe:

a. Building a tower (verses 28-30)

b. Going to war (verses 31-32)

2. From Luke 14:33 record Jesus' requirement for being *His disciple*.

a. Share a practical cost of discipleship today.

Day 4: Read Luke 15:1-10

How does the Bible describe those who "drew near to Jesus?" Luke 15:1

a. How did the Pharisees react to this? Luke 15:2

Day 5: Review

1. What lesson(s) from chapter 14 of Luke stand out to you the most this week?

2. Which lessons can be directly applied to situations in your life right now, and what do you find the Lord speaking to you through them?
