Lesson 18

Day 1: Read Luke 19:1-10

How did Jesus describe what had happened to Zacchaeus? Luke 19:9

a. Chief tax collectors, like Zacchaeus, were hated because they raised taxes unreasonably for their personal profit. How does this make Jesus' statement remarkable?

Day 2: Read Luke 19:11-27

In Luke 19:11 Jesus spoke *another parable*. What were His two reasons for doing so?

Day 3: Read Luke 19:28-40

When He had said this, He went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. And it came to pass, when He drew near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mountain called Olivet, that He sent two of His disciples with specific instructions (Luke 19:28-29). Use Luke 19:30-31 to record Jesus' instructions to these disciples.

Day 4: Read Luke 19:41-48

1. What was Jesus' reaction when He saw Jerusalem? Luke 19:41



2. What does this communicate to you about Jesus? See also Luke 13:34.

b. What did Jesus lament over? Luke 19:42
