## THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

### Luke 20

Lesson 19

Day 1: Read Luke 20:1-8

After driving out the moneychangers (Luke 19:45), what did Jesus do in the temple? Luke 20:1a

a. What happened as He was doing this? Luke 20:1b

Day 2: Read Luke 20:9-18

1. In Luke 20:9-15 Jesus told the people this parable about a man with a vineyard who leased it to vinedressers, and went into a far country. Note and comment on what happened at vintage-time:

a. To the owner's servants (verses 10-12)

b. To the owner's beloved son (verses 13-15a)

2. The beloved son represented Jesus. What was He revealing through this parable?

Day 3: Read Luke 20:19-26

These leaders tried to entrap Jesus with a political question. From Luke 20:21-23 remark on:

a. What they admitted to knowing about Jesus (verse 21)



b. The question they asked (verse 22)

c. Their motivation for asking (verse 23a)

Day 4: Read Luke 20:27-47

In Luke 20:27 the Sadducees presented a hypothetical scenario to Jesus. Summarize this from Luke 20:28-33.

a. Observe that the Sadducees denied the existence of a resurrection (Luke 20:27). What does this convey to you about their question?

Day 5: Review

1. What lesson(s) stand out to you the most this week from Luke chapter 20?

2. Which lessons can be directly applied to situations in your life right now, and what do you find the Lord speaking to you through them?
