Day 1: Read Luke 3:1-20

Before describing the ministry of John the Baptist, Luke set the stage for the next series of events by describing the political scene at that time. Observe this description in Luke 3:1-2a. Why do you think he did this?

Day 2: Read Luke 3:7-14

Why does John attack the Jews' security in being Abraham's children? (Luke 3:8)

a. Why is this important?

Day 3: Read Luke 3:15-20

John's message was "good news" for the people, yet his exhortations were strong, blunt, and to the point. What was the good news of John's message?



Day 4: Read Luke 3:21-38

Luke 3:23-38 records the genealogy of Jesus through Mary. Share why you think this was important to record.

a. What names from this list stand out to you, and why.

Day 5: Review

1. What lesson(s) from chapter 3 of Luke stand out to you the most this week?

2. Which lessons can be directly applied to situations in your life right now, and what do you find the Lord speaking to you through them?
