## THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

### Luke 7

Lesson 7

#### Day 1: Read Luke 7:1-10

As Jesus drew near the house, the centurion sent friends to Him with a message (Luke 7:6a). Read this message in Luke 7:6b-8 (ESV). *"Lord, do not trouble yourself, for I am not worthy to have you come under my roof. Therefore I did not presume to come to you. But say the word, and let my servant be healed. For I too am a man set under authority, with soldiers under me: and I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."* Comment on the centurion's:

a. View of Jesus

b. Perspective on authority

#### Day 2: Read Luke 7:11-17

According to Luke 7:11, what happened the day after the centurion's servant was healed?

#### Day 3: Read Luke 7:18 - 30

After Jesus' miracles, the disciples of John reported to him (Luke 7:18). John sent two of his disciples to Jesus with a question. What was it? Luke 7:19-20

a. At that time, John the Baptist was languishing in Herod's prison (Mark 6:17-19) and John's ministry was severely limited. How might this explain his question?



Day 4: Read Luke 7:31 - 35

Jesus explained His illustration in Luke 7:33-34. Use these verses to describe and comment on the people's complaints about:

a. John the Baptist

b. The Son of Man (Jesus)

(1) What does this reveal about human nature?

1. What lesson(s) from chapter 7 of Luke stand out to you the most this week?

2. Which lessons can be directly applied to situations in your life right now, and what do you find the Lord speaking to you through them?
